




7.0 Powers of the Board of Trustees

- 7.4 To accept the management of any educational Trust fund or endowment or rollglous in which the Trust is interested



- 7.13To accumulate the income of the Trust and to amalgamate the same with one corpus of the Trust and any income of the Trust not spent in a year unless otherwise determined by the Board of Trustees be deemed to be accumulated by the Trust.
- 7.14 To make suitable grants of money or other assistance to a university, Educational institution or other Society. Or Trust for the conducting or the prosecution of any research, investigation, study in a subject in which the Trust is Interested.
- 7.15 To grant fellowships, scholarships, or any monetary assistance on such terms and conditions as they may prescribe to such persons as they may select for carrying on any research, investigation or study in matters which the Trust is interested.
- 7.16 To manage, lease, rent out, at such rent or lease as they may deem fit or sell, transfer or otherwise dispose off any movable or immovable property owned or leased by the Trust.
- 7.17 To receive, collect and enforce recovery of the money due to the Trust and grant receipts and discharge therefore.



- 7.30 To prove welfare, housing, transport facilities to the employees and to the full time Directors working for the administration of Trust objectives.
- 7.31 To make such rules and regulations from time to time for proper management and conduct of the affairs of the Trust and its properties and assets.

7.32 To help promote, contribute, take over any other society, trust body of institutions incorporated for the objects similar to those of the trust herein.

7.33 To let out, dispose any immovable property comprised in the Trust fund for such period and on such rent and such terms and conditions as the Chairman Trustee in his absolute discretion shall think and to obtain property or building on leasing on such terms may be deemed just and proper.

7.34 To enter into contract on behalf of the Trust and rescind them.

7.35 To Purchase acquire movable and immovable properties for the Trust can be in the name of the trust executed by the Founder Chairman SRI. ARJUN BONSLE or with prior permission by Vice-Chairman VANI ARJUN. Except the properties purchased in the name of the Trust, the Trusties can have or hold their individual properties acquired by them in their individual capacity and with their personal/Professional income. 7.37 BORROWING THE FUNDS: To borrow loans, funds overdraft, cash credit, term loans from the Banks, financial institutions and other institutions or persons as the Board of Trustees deem fit and the Chairman & Vice-Chairman will have the power to sign legal documents.

7.38 Any decision taken by The Chairman & Vice-Chairman, at any trust meeting shall be valid binding and final on all the Trustees and power so vested in of exercisable by the said Trustees shall be valid-and binding on the trust.


7.39 The Board of Trustees will have powers to invest the funds in any manner as they think deem fit either in the movable or immovable properties.

8.02 The powers of Board of Trustees shall be so exercised as to ensure that the income of the Trust would be exempt under Section 11 of the Income Tax Act 1961 as read with Sections 12, 12A amended from time to time. It is clarified that the power of investment of the Trust funds including those mentioned in clause 6(iv) shall be exercised in accordance with the provisions of Sections 13 of the Income Tax Act, 1961 in general and in particular shall not violate the provisions of 4 Sections 13(1) (d) read with section 13(5) of the Act so as to ensure exemption under the Act.

8.03 All securities and investments, properties both movable and immovable or any assets standing in the name of Trust are exclusive properties of the Trust and other properties if any in the name of individual properties of the Trustees acquired by them on their own income are not considered as Trust properties.

8.4 The funds and the income of the Trust shall be solely utilized towards the achievement of the objectives of the Trust.

9.0 TRUSTEES APPOINTMENT, RETIREMENT AND DUTIES:


9.1 TRUSTEES AND REMUNERATION. The Trustees may however, reimburse themselves and pay and discharge out of the trust property all costs, charges and expenses bonafidely incurred by them, incurred in or above a promotion or execution of the objects of the Trust. Any of the Trustees renders services independently, he/she being Trustee of the Trust, on full time basis, shall be entitled for remuneration and benefits The five Trusties apart from the Trust activities can do their independent business/profession without disturbing the objectives of the Trust and can hold the properties in their independent names which can be accrued with their independent source of income. If the Trustees allot their full time for the welfare of the Trust, all their personal expenses shall be born by the Trust.

9.2 IDENTITY: The Trustees shall be kept fully indemnity and harmless by the trust against any claim, demand on liability arising, against them for anything done by them and to trustee shall be liable for any loss caused to the trust by any act of thing committed or done by such Trustees, if the Trustees was acting in good faith and in proper discharges of his duties towards the trust and it is his/her responsibility to give cause to the Trust .

9.3 The number of Trustees including the founder Trustee or Chairman shall not be less than two or more than nine.


9.4 The Board of Trustees (governing body) shall be three in number.

- 9.5 SRI.ARJUN BONSLE shall be the Chairman of the Trust for his life time Trust for the Founder Chairman SRI.ARJUN BONSLE will have powers to nominate the chairman in his place by a letter in writing IN FUTURE.
- 9.6 Subject to the Clause 10 .3 above the Chairman and Vic-Chairman may from time to time by an instrument in writing under their hands can terminate the services of the present Trustee or can appoint an additional Trustee or a new Trustee to fill a vacancy and such Trustee or Trustees shall hold office for the time mentioned by the Chairman.
- 9.7 Any trustee may resign on giving ONE month prior notice to the remaining Trustees. The Trustee/s are also entitled to form any number of Trusts or part of any additional Trust which may be for the welfare of the society in large.
- 9.8 Any trustee shall be deemed to have been discharged and his office shall become vacant on the happening of all or any of the following events.
- a) If/he/she is found to be unsound mind by a court or competent authority.
- b) If/he/she is adjudicated or if he/she applies to be so adjudicated.
- c) Except the Chairman or the founder trustee & Vice-Chairman the other Trustees shall be deemed to have been discharged and his/her office shall become vacant if the remaining Trustees at a formal meeting pass a resolution by majority. (Which resolution shall not be opened to question) declaring that the said Trustee has acted in a manner prejudicial, to the interest of the Trust or his/her, continuance as a Trustee is considered otherwise undesirable.
- d) There shall be a Chairman of the Board of Trustees. The said SRI.ARIUN BONSLE shall be the Chairman for his life time.
- e) The said SRI.ARJUN BONSLE shall be entitled to nominate any person as Trustee to fill the vacancy arising on his/her resignation or death and such person shall be the Chairman of the Board and exercise of the powers of the Chairman. In the absence of any such nomination the Vice-Chairman shall be Chairman of the trust.
- f) The Chairman shall exercise powers as may be reserved to him by the Board by the Board of Trustees and without prejudice to the generality of this clause the Chairman shall be entitled to review periodically the work and progress of the Trust and to issue directions for its development which shall be carried out by the Board of Trustees.

g) The powers exercisable by the office bearers namely the Chairman Vice-Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer shall be as follows.

10:0 BOARD OF TRUSTEES OR OFFICE BEARES:

10.1 CHAIRMAN

The Chairman is the supreme head of the Trust and shall preside over all the meetings of the Board of Trustees, sub-committees, ad-hoc committees etc. when both the Chairman and vice chairman are absent, the Secretary with prior permission from the Chairman, shall preside. The Chairman shall have powers to summon the meeting of the Board of Trustees, if the exigency of the situation so demands on emergency basis within 24 hours. (The Chairman is empowered to sign, execute and register important instruments legal documents relating to the affairs of the trust. The Chairman or With written permission from him, the Vic-Chairman is also authorized to open bank accounts, borrow money from banks and other financial institutions as and when required for the Trust.

10.2 VICE CHAIRMAN:

The Vice Chairman shall assist the Chairman in the formulation of the schemes and activities and shall preside over the meetings of the Board in the absence of the Chairman.

10.3 SECRETARY

She/He shall be the principal executive officer of the Trust and execute all the decisions and resolutions passed by the Board in the right earnest. He shall at all times keep the Chairman and the Vice Chairman informed of all the important developments and other activities.

10.4TREASURER


She/He shall in consultation with the Chairman or the Vice-Chairman convene the meeting and maintain a systematic record of the minutes of such meetings. She/He shall attend to all the matters of general administration in accordance with the directions of the Board of trust.

11.0 MEETINGS AND BUSINESS TRANSACTIONS BY THE TRUSTEES:

The Trustees may meet as often as may be necessary for the conduct of the business of the Trust at Bangalore or any other place as decided by the Board of Trustees.


- 11.1 The Quorum required for the meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be five. In the case of meeting adjourned for want of quorum, the members present shall themselves constitute the quorum, subject to a minimum of two.
- 11.2 All decisions of the Board of Trustees may be taken by a simple majority 2 except as expressly provided for otherwise herein. The final approval of the said decision shall be by the Chairman only.
- 11.3 The Chairman of the meeting shall be entitled to an extra casting vote in the event of equality of votes at meeting
- 11.4 At least one week's notice in writing shall be given for every meeting of the Board of Trustees, provided, however, that the Chairman shall have powers to convene meeting at shorter notice for transacting any business considered by him /her to be urgent.
- 11.5 Minutes of the Meetings and all Major transactions are to be recorded in the Minutes Book.
- 12.0 FRAMING/AMENDING OF RULES AND BYE-LAWS; The Chairman of Trust may frame rules and Bye-Laws for the management of the Trust, its institutions, properties, projects and the proceedings of the Trustees, and amend or rescind them as it doems fit.
- 13.0 ACCOUNTS AND AUDITIING: The Trust shall maintain true and correct accounts of all receipts and expenses and disposal of the funds and proporties of the Trust and a correct record of their meetings and deliberations. For the purpose of Accounting, the year shall be 31st March, of every year. The accounts, shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant duly appointed.

14.0 IRREVOCABILITY AND AMENDMENTS TO THE TRUST:

The trust hereby created is irrevocable. The provisions of this deed may be amended if the Chairman and Vice Chairman of Trustees unanimously so decide, it is hereby made clear that the Chairman and Vice Chairman shall have power to make, from time to time all such amendments as may be required to secure recognition, exemptions and reliefs under the Income Tax Act or other fiscal laws or as may be found necessary for the smooth working of the Trust or for the purpose of seeking recognition, aid or affiliation to the institutions of the trust. Provided that the Charter of this Trust as an-Educational trust shall not be altered however no amendments to the Trust deed shall be made which may be prove to be repugnant to the provision of section 2(15) ,11,12,13 and 80G of the income tax Act, 1961 as amended from time to time amendments shall be carried out without the prior permission of the Chairman and Vice Chairman.

16.0 DISSOLUTION: In the event of dissolution or winding of the Trust, the assets remaining as on the date of dissolution shall under no circumstances be distributed among the Trustees, but the same shall be transferred to another Educational/Hindu religious or Charitable Trust, Society, Association Institutions, whose objectives are similar to those of this Trust and which enjoys recognition under Section 80G of the income Tax Act, 1961.
